# Why do we Plant Trees?

Trees take on their own meaning for each of us. For many, there is an emotional connection to trees. ### Who is BGPP?

Our goal is to plant 50 million trees by 2026, and invite Canadian's to join us by making change a habit.

# **Work with us**

### **How this Works**

Partner with us and invite your customers to plant trees for the BGPP mission by contributing as little as \$0.25 per cup of coffee. If a voluntary contribution model does not feel right for you, we can work together to find a tree planting model that tailored to your needs.

The cost to plant a tree is \$1.42. This includes the entire lifecycle, including project planning, seedling growth, planting of the tree, and independent verification from foresters and our Partners at PWC.

Once a tree is planted you receive confirmation that your coffee shop has planted a tree, and you begin on your journey to planting a forest with your patrons.

Our commitment to you is that we will plant trees you can be proud of. We will proudly display your coffee shop as a Partner in Sustainability in alignment to with our mission.

#### **How Can I Join?**

We want to invite you to join us and align with our mission. If we have reached out to you, have a conversation with our team so we can explain how this all works.

If we haven't reached out to you, contact us! We would love to tell you how this works, and at the very least have a stimulating conversation about climate change, and the importance of healthy forests.

The only requirement to join is a shared commitment to our vision. We will provide you with a contribution agreement that will guarantee that your contributions go towards planting trees and sequestering carbon.

## How will I know where and when the trees will be planted?

We plant trees in Canada's Western Boreal Forest that would not be planted otherwise. The locations of each of our planting projects will be made available on our website, and each partner will receive confirmation where and when each project has been completed, and audited by a third party.

Traditionally the main focus of tree-planting companies was to service the legal obligations of the forestry sector - a sector that has guided mainly by the value of the fibre in the trees. This is shifting and more and more forested land is being managed for other values.

These are trees that will draw carbon from the atmosphere, help restore the forests to prevent wildfires and retain water to prevent flooding, and so much more. BGPP works with partners and forestry experts to develop quality planting projects to optimize for carbon sequestration, enhanced forest health and community values.

The understanding of forest health is an evolving science and we are constantly adapting our approach in consolation with experts to find the best approach.

### How will Joining BGPP benefit my business?

BGPP provides your business with the ability to complement your existing business model by integrating sustainability into you and your customers everyday choices at no direct cost to your coffee shop. Our intention with this project is to promote businesses who pursue a triple P bottom line, People, Planet and Profit.
